- Deployments (when a spouse or loved one is away overseas or out of country on a tour that can sometimes be 6 months to a year)
- TD: Temporary Duty (sometimes away for 3-6 months on a short tour or only 3-6 weeks and usually within Canada or on special assignment like when there is a flood, hurricane, etc)
- Promotion: Someone is getting promoted from one rank to another. I took a picture off of Facebook and sent a card.
- Posted: this is when you are moving or relocating to a new position. I sent a card to their old house with a picture of their new house congratulating them and offering support while they were getting ready to move.
- New Baby
- Receiving Awards or Accommodations for achievements
- Retirement (invitations or congratulations)
- Family Members enlisting: Members of the family joining the forces
- Graduations
- Family being far away and just staying in touch
- Ladies Social Events: book clubs, craft nights, meet and greets
- Christmas cards, mother's day, father's day, birthdays, anniversaries, weddings, births
