New News on PPP Loan Forgiveness

The Small Business Administration has recently opened their portal to accept PPP loan forgiveness applications and several banks have announced that they will accept forgiveness applications from their borrowers. However, Congress is considering changing the rules on loan forgiveness, so unless an organization is very confident of 100% forgiveness, JFNA recommends that borrowers consider waiting before submitting their applications until Congress acts.
