In trying to make the High Holidays as enjoyable and as safe as possible the Beth Shalom Board would like you to be aware

of the following.

Through out the past year we participated in a security audit at Beth Shalom. The audit produced many valuable suggestions for improving the safety and security at Beth Shalom. After considering the recommendations provided, the Beth Shalom Board has decided to implement the following safety and security upgrades during the upcoming High Holidays.

- Four security guards will be onsite at all times.
- Arrive as early as possible to ensure you have a place to park your car and to ensure you are seated before services begin.
- Congregants are asked to enter the synagogue through the back door on the north side of the building.
- Please have your tickets ready to show, to the security guards, when you are entering the building.
- Congregants who use the elevator, to access the sanctuary, should enter the building through the front side door on the west of the building.
- Disabled/ elderly parking is available at the front of the synagogue. Please contact Helena in the office at 780 488-6333 ext. 301 to obtain a city of Edmonton parking pass to place in your car. Cars without a pass can be towed.
- Parking is available on the Connelly-McKinley parking lot. A shuttle service will run between the lot and the synagogue.
