May 11 - Chapters 1, 2 and 6 1 and 2: Census and arrangement of the camp – 6: Law of the Nazarites

May 18 - Chapter 10	Silver trumpets and the journey begins
Chapter 11	People complain about having only manna
Chapter 12	Aaron and Miriam questions Moses’ authority

May 25 - Chapters 13 and 14 Spies report, people’s rebellion, and sentence of 40 years in the wilderness

Chapters 16 and 17	Levites rebellion and confirmation of Aaron
Chapter 20	Water at Meribah and Moses striking the rock

June 1 - Chapter 21 People complain, fiery serpents and the Bronze Serpent
Chapters 22-24 Balaam and his prophecies
Chapter 25 Rebellion, plague and mercy at Peor
Chapters 32 and 34 Land east of Jordon settled, recap of the journey and, ready to enter the Promised Land
