Truth

God said that light should shine out of the darkness. He is the same one who shone in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:6 (CEB)

Whenever life seems dark, turning on lights of truth opens the door to escape from misunderstanding, and more importantly, move toward sympathetic opinions of differences. This truth instills a powerful radiance that cannot be resisted. Take a moment to visualize yourself immersed in a divine glow. Become more relaxed. Let go. Trust the inner illumination as it guides you to the answers. Have courage to be who you are and willingly accept others as they are.
