to become, both in creed and deed, the children of the living God.**

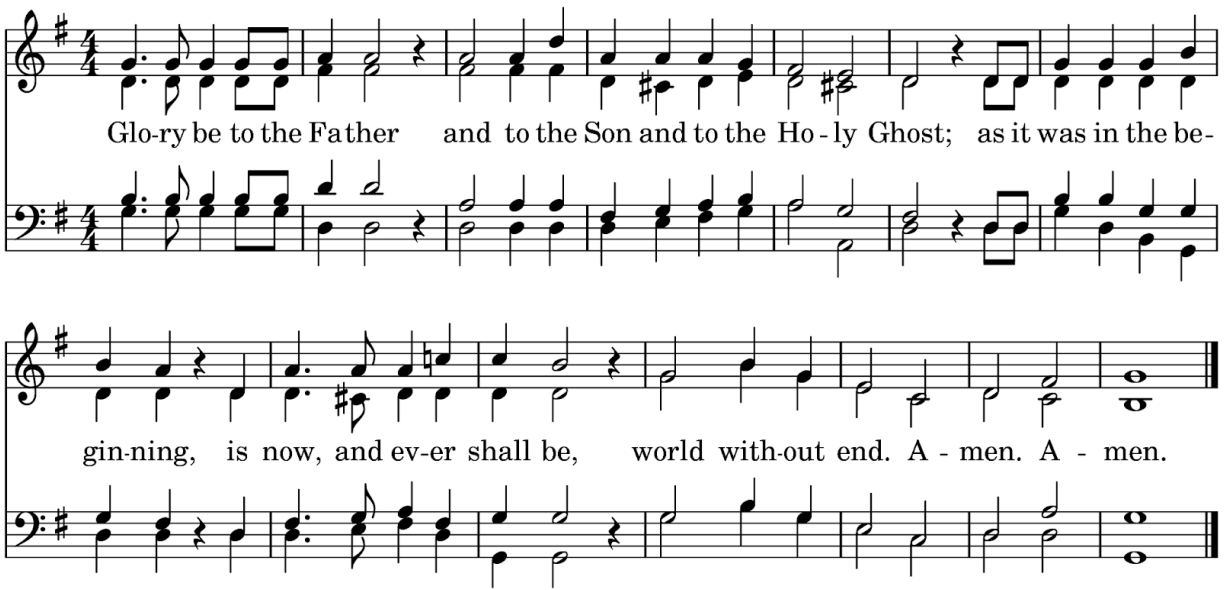
**I believe in the Spirit by whom Jesus still comes to us,
