Gerald Robinson and I have plans to present these chapters through Imagineering. Our objective is to share the story from the perspective of the People who will be wandering the desert for the next forty years. We finished the study from Exodus about their escape from Egypt, their anxiety over food and water, their desire to have a tangible representation of God, and ultimately receiving the Ten Commandments.

Now they will be continuing the journey after causing God to sentence them to forty years of wandering. You will learn about the processes for organizing the people, how the laws were to be administered, how Moses continued to rebel against God and the consequences of his actions, and more about plagues they experience in the Desert.
