Lion's Fund

The school's annual giving program, the Lion's Fund, helps support every aspect of a St. Andrew's education. Making a gift to the Lion's Fund is a St. Andrew's tradition. Without the Lion's Fund, many of our field trips would have to be scaled back, our athletics teams might need to use older equipment and our arts program would perform on bare stages. St. Andrew's, like all independent schools, supplements its tuition revenue with an annual giving drive. As a result, annual giving is essential to our school's program. Of all the ways that a parent can support St. Andrew's, the Lion's Fund is our highest priority.

For the past three years, 100% of faculty and staff have invested in St. Andrew's by joining the Lion's Fund. Our goal is to match their

commitment with 100% parent participation. Participation is a tradition at St. Andrew's and it sends a message to prospective faculty, prospective families, and charitable foundations that we care about and support our school. Low participation discourages donors at the leadership level and can put our grant applications at risk.

toward helping our school each year. Gifts to the Lion's Fund are spent in the same academic year in which they are given and make an immediate impact in enhancing your child's St. Andrew's experience.
