

College Fee Waiver Exception Process:

Non-traditional high school students (GED or home school) and transfers from two- or four-year colleges may request a fee waiver based on the student's qualification for a minimum of \$4,500 in Federal Pell Grants during the academic year in which the student registers with the NAIA Eligibility Center if:

- Their high school is unable to obtain fee waiver confirmation or;
- The student's financial circumstances have materially changed since high school graduation.

How to Send Collegiate Fee Waiver:

1. The student's high school denies the fee waiver through the NAIA High School Portal.
2. Student obtains a copy of their financial aid award letter, in a school sealed envelope, and mails it to the eligibility center themselves.
3. If the student meets the minimum of \$4,500 in Federal Pell Grant funds and the profile shows a denied high school waiver, the fee waiver will be approved.

*Home school and GED/HiSet students will need to send in their financial aid award letter using the above method and do not need to have a high school fee waiver denial on their profile.
