

TLC Lutheran Education Advancement Endowment Fund

The TLC Lutheran Education Advancement Endowment Fund (the “Fund”) was established in 2012 by Trinity Lutheran Church, Reseda, CA, as a separate fund of the LCMS Foundation to be used to further the mission and ministry of Lutheran education in the Pacific Southwest District.

The annual fair market value of the Fund will be determined on June 30 of each year. The fair market value will include the entire principal balance of the Fund, together with any accrued income. Distributions will occur semiannually each year. The first distribution will be made in February and the second distribution will be made in August, on an annual basis.

Distribution of the “Fund’s” interest shall be made to a qualified educational organization as set forth in the Endowment Fund’s original charter.

Distribution of the Fund shall be determined by the Pacific Southwest District President and the Executive Director of Schools Ministries and others as appointed.

Deadline to apply is January 31, 2021

Purpose of the Fund:

The grant from the Fund that is awarded shall be used to further the educational mission of the school. Priority will be given to special non-budgeted projects or activities that will enhance the quality and reach of the educational experience.

Who can apply?

Elementary and Secondary Schools/congregations that are members of the Pacific Southwest District of The Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod.

Grant recipients will be notified in mid-February.

Funds will be released twice - in February and in August. Recipients will be based on the need of the school and the strength of the application.
