Dr. David Miyashiro currently serves as Superintendent of the Cajon Valley Union School District and was named 2016 Superintendent of the Year by the Association of California School Administrators, Region 18. David pioneered and franchised a modern “World of Work” curriculum focused on helping children find their passions and building, from kindergarten, ways to show children how those passions can translate to jobs. He launched a TEDxKids@ElCajon conference to showcase children’s talents on a globally broadcast platform, and to get them to learn presentation skills. David formerly served as the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services for the Encinitas Union School District and as a Principal in the Fullerton and East Whittier School Districts. Most recently, Dr. Miyashiro was appointed by the CA State Board of Education to serve as co-chair for California’s committee tasked with bringing Computer Science to all K-12 students, and was also appointed to the California School Boards Association President’s advisory council.

Ed Hidalgo is the chief innovation and engagement officer for the Cajon Valley Union School District. He is focused on advancing the mission of developing happy kids, living in healthy relationships on a path to gainful employment through the development and integration of the World of Work™ initiative. Prior to his work in Cajon Valley, Ed held leadership roles at the Jacob’s Institute for Innovation in Education at the University of San Diego, in Human Resources and Government Affairs for Qualcomm, and Staffing Management for Manpower of San Diego. He is a workforce board member for the San Diego Workforce Partnership.
