KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

The **Immigrant Legal Resource Center** (ILCR.org) advocates for community members to work together to fight messages of fear and panic by helping community members learn about their rights and how to protect themselves from ICE. Message to ICE officers: You are not allowed to enter the property, and I will not open the door unless you have a judicial warrant signed by a judge. If you have a judicial warrant signed by a judge, please show it to me. If you do not have a valid judicial warrant signed by a judge, you do not have the right to enter this home / this church. I DO NOT give you permission to enter this home / this church. I will call my attorney. (from B. Munroe)
