### **UPDATES FOR SENIORS**

**College Deadlines** – January 1 is a big deadline for many colleges. If you continue adding schools to apply to, please make sure you are communicating this information with your counselor. If you still need to order transcripts sent to colleges please do so before winter break. You can order transcripts using this link.

**Cal State and select UC campuses have extended their deadlines** – all Cal States have extended their application deadline to December 15. UC Merced, UC Riverside and UC Santa Cruz have also extended their application deadline until December 15.

Check your Email for College Information – A reminder to seniors to check your email (including junk mail) for important information from the colleges you applied to regarding application requirements and missing documents. Respond promptly to any requests!

**Financial Aid** – The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), California Dream Act Application and CSS Profile are now available to file. We recommend you apply now. If you plan to attend college in California you will want to submit your FAFSA before the March deadline. For more information check out the CCC Financial aid information section on our website.

**Community College** – You can now apply to El Camino for Fall 2021. Considering applying for the South Bay Promise to get your first two years at El Camino for free (click <u>here</u> for more information). Visit El Camino's website <u>here</u>.

# **UPDATES FOR JUNIORS**

**Attend Virtual College Visits** – This is your chance to learn more about the colleges you are interested in applying to. You can view the list of upcoming visits and sign up to attend on your Naviance ac- count.

**Naviance** – Utilize the research tools in Naviance to start researching which colleges are a good fit. As a reminder, you must now sign on to Naviance using your SSO portal and click on your Naviance tile to access your account. We recommend checking out the SuperMatch feature!

**PSAT/NMSQT Exam** – If you registered to take the PSAT/NMSQT test on January 26, 2021, you will receive test information via emails from Total Registration. You are responsible for reading those emails for instructions and details. You are also responsible for bringing the testing items you will need. Click <a href="here">here</a> for a checklist of what you need to bring.

SENIOR CLASS OF 2021: You still have time to apply to the Cal States and some UC campuses!

CLASS OF 2022 & 2023: Take a FREE, PROCTORED, PRACTICE PSAT remotely in the safety of your home!

Do not confuse this opportunity with the Official PSAT/NMSQT that is scheduled for January 26<sup>th</sup>! We understand that there are downsides to the in-person Official PSAT/NMSQT exam scheduled for January 26<sup>th</sup> (possible cancelations, several weeks/months to turn around scores) — so we are hosting a virtual,

**PRACTICE PSAT** on **January 9**<sup>th</sup> that is open to all sophomores and juniors!

<u>IMPORTANT!!</u> This PRACTICE PSAT on January 9<sup>th</sup> IS NOT IN ANY WAY connected to National Merit Scholarship opportunities... this is only an opportunity to take a PRACTICE test!

Families will **receive results promptly** (within a week to 10 days!) and our students will be on track in terms of advising and considering how testing **may or may not fit into their spring plans**. Students can complete a **nocost, proctored PSAT with Compass Education safely and remotely** and you'll have a score report back before the Official PSAT/NMSQT that should take place later in the month.

Students may use this opportunity as **practice to prep** for the January 26<sup>th</sup> official PSAT/NMSQT, or simply to **be exposed to and take a proctored PSAT** and end up with a **useful diagnostic assessment and practice score** in hand. **REGISTRATION:** *Everything you need to take the test will be in the auto-generated confirmation email that you receive after completing the registration.* Students will be emailed their scores within ten days of testing, and there is NO OBLIGATION to contact Compass Education for explanation of the score report. **REGISTER HERE! Registration closes January 2, 2021!**
