
A Deafening Silence?

Christian Faith leaders were pivotal in the civil rights movement, the anti-Vietnam War movement, and the boycotts that ended apartheid in South Africa. And yet — after more than 77 years of harsh military occupation, Palestinian home demolitions and forced removal in the West Bank, and 18 years of a blockade culminating Israel's carpet bombing, starvation and genocide in Gaza — many U.S. faith leaders seem largely silent.
