When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

## A Message from Pastor Mark

Naples UCC Family,

As another exciting and meaningful season of church life winds down at Naples UCC, I wanted to let you know about a new direction in our search for a Minister for Congregational Care and Mission. After careful consideration, a consensus decision has been made to look for an interim minister to fill this role in the near future. This decision was arrived at based on the concurrence of the Search Committee, the Executive Committee, and the Senior Minister. Together, we discerned this course of action to be both wise and prudent.

While we had all hoped to have a candidate to present to the congregation by now for the settled position, that candidate was not identified in spite of the diligent efforts of our Search Committee. Because ministers do not generally look for new positions in the summer, we have decided to stop the current search to allow time for the Executive Committee to retain an interim minister to serve our congregation in the near term.

This decision will also allow our church's leadership the time needed to re-examine our profile, to better analyze the "market," and to re-draft our ministry job description based on what we learned in recent months. Our leadership team plans to complete these critical tasks prior to starting a new search, likely to commence in the early fall. To that end, we have already begun work on these initiatives with the Florida Conference of the UCC, and we will continue to work with them and others to better position ourselves to find just the right candidate to serve our awesome church. I will be sure to keep the congregation posted on developments as they happen.

With significant gratitude, I give thanks to the Search Committee for their diligent efforts and hard work.

## Volunteer Needed to Coordinate Cans For Communion

Naples United Church of Christ is looking for a volunteer to coordinate the Cans for Communion food donations, which support Grace Place's Food Pantry. Nonperishable food items are collected from our congregation once a month on Communion Sunday. These donations are picked up by Grace Place and distributed to eligible individuals and families experiencing food insecurity.

Coordinator responsibilities include scheduling six volunteers for each service on the first Sunday of the month (October through May), bringing boxes to the church for packing donated food, and communicating with Grace Place staff. The Coordinator does not need to lift heavy boxes and will have the support of a dedicated team of volunteers who currently assist with receiving and packing donations on Communion Sundays.

Children & Youth Ministry


SUNDAYS —We are so happy to have families with young children in our midst! Regular Sunday morning
