On November 11 at 3:30 p.m. in McSpadden Hall, Paul Hiltz, CEO of NCH Health Systems, and Jamie Ulmer, CEO of Healthcare Network, will speak about the challenges of providing exemplary healthcare services in our area with the possibility of the ACA (Affordable Care Act) subsidy benefits ending on December 31st. Approximately 4.7 million Floridians have an ACA insurance plan, representing the largest number of enrollees in the nation with 98% qualifying for some level of financial assistance. The loss of health insurance for many affected will have far reaching effects on the Naples Healthcare systems. This free Justice program will be open to the community and you are asked to register to ensure a seat. Call the church office or use the QR code to register.

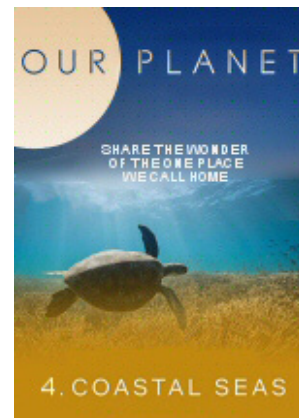

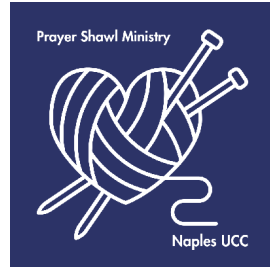


Prayer Shawl Ministry

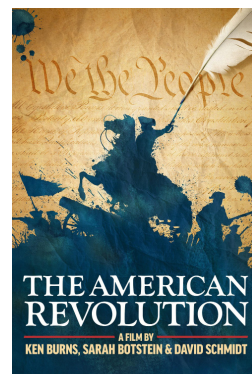
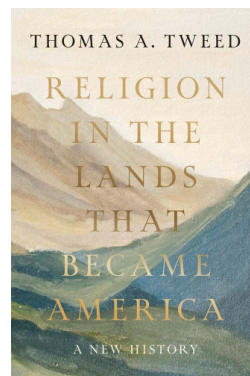
Calling All Baby Boomers!
