# Important Special Church Meeting to Authorize Leasing

SUNDAY, APRIL 21, AT 12:15 P.M.

If you are a full or associate member of NUCC, please make plans to attend a Special Meeting of the membership on Sunday, April 21, 2024, at 12:15 p.m., immediately after the second service in the Sanctuary. The membership will be voting to authorize NUCC to enter into a long-term lease of that portion of the church campus formerly used for the operation of Precious Cargo Academy to a third-party tenant for the purposes of operating a child daycare and/or preschool. A letter was sent to the membership by email on April 2 with more specifics and with a Zoom webinar link for those members unable to attend in person. We must have a quorum to approve this important action for the church. 


