Important Special Church Meeting to Authorize Leasing

SUNDAY, APRIL 21, AT 12:15 P.M.

If you are a full or associate member of NUCC, please make plans to attend a Special Meeting of the membership on Sunday, April 21, 2024, at 12:15 p.m., immediately after the second service in the Sanctuary. The membership will be voting to authorize NUCC to enter into a long-term lease of that portion of the church campus formerly used for the operation of Precious Cargo Academy to a third-party tenant for the purposes of operating a child daycare and/or preschool. A letter was sent to the membership by email on April 2 with more specifics and with a Zoom webinar link for those members unable to attend in person. We must have a quorum to approve this important action for the church. If you are unable to attend in person or by Zoom, please fill out the proxy form which was sent with the April 2 email and turn it into the church office before Sunday, April 21. The Deacons will also have proxy forms available on Sunday mornings and will take your completed proxy.

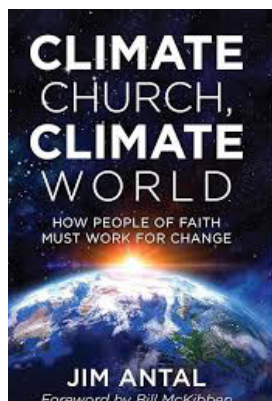

Prayer Shawl Ministry

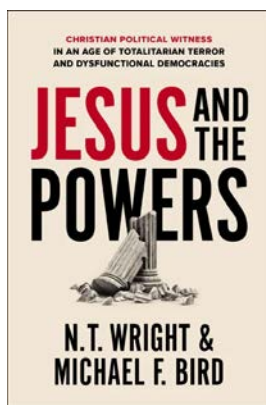

SATURDAY, APRIL 20 AT 1 P.M., WEBINAR

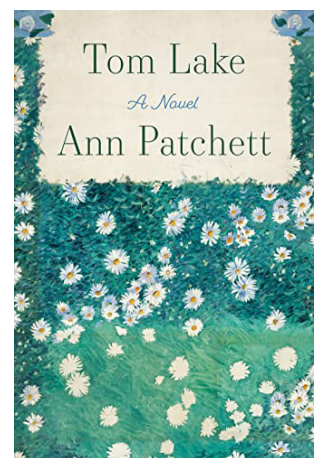

The Naples UCC Book Club will discuss *Tom Lake*, a novel by Ann Patchett. *Tom Lake* is a meditation on youthful love, married love, and the lives parents have led before their children were born. Both hopeful and elegiac, it explores what it means to be happy even when the world is falling apart. It is a gentle read, sharing the joy and extraordinary in the ordinary of being together on a family cherry farm in Michigan.

As in all of her novels, Ann Patchett combines compelling narrative artistry with piercing insights into family dynamics. This novel is about storytelling at its best, reminding the reader that everyone has a story to share, as ordinary as their life may seem. The result is a rich and luminous story, told with profound intelligence and emotional subtlety. Ann Patchett has had a life-long fascination with the play *Our Town*, by Thornton Wilder and while not necessary to read the play in advance of this book, you'll certainly want to afterwards if you haven't already. The discussion of *Tom Lake* will be facilitated by Heather English. Newcomers are always welcome, even if you haven't read the book!

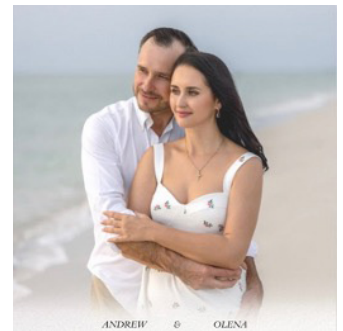
Bargain Box Focused Donation Drive
