FIST MISSION STATEMENT

GRANT GUIDELINES

Grants of up to \$1000 will be awarded to a nonprofit organization activities and or projects **that correspond with the FIST Mission Statement.**

FIST will not fund shipping/handling, food items and transportation costs.

Any nonprofit organization in Steuben County or that serves Steuben County is eligible to apply, including churches and service clubs.

If selected to receive a FIST Grant, you will be given a Grant Agreement and submit a Final Report. Failure to fulfill these requirements will jeopardize future grant requests.

HOW TO APPLY

Fill out a grant application on the Steuben County Community Foundation website.

The application requires a description of the project, itemized budget or estimates, and must demonstrate how it connects with the mission of FIST.

DEADLINES

This is an open grant cycle, and requests will be accepted until May 1, 2019. FIST meets once in a month in February, March, April, and May to review grant applications.
