# ARRIVAL AND CHECKIN

Each Patrol/Webelos Den will unload at the Parking Lot.

Boy Scouts and their Adult Leaders will backpack all their personal gear needed for the weekend to their designated campsite via Camporee Registration.

(One vehicle per Troop for Kitchen and Food)

Webelos Dens will hike to their designated campsite via Camporee Registration with a knapsack containing their personal gear.

(Webelos Dens will be permitted the use of a vehicle for their camp equipment)

The Patrol/Webelos Den should register when all of its members are present. Registration is between 5:00PM and 8:00PM Friday evening at Camporee Headquarters.

The cost for the Camporee is \$20 for each participant

Items needed for registration:

Cash or check for the total amount due for the Patrol/Webelos Den ie. 8 members X \$20 = \$160

Patrol Registration Sheet (included in this pamphlet)

Medical Forms Parts B and C for each participant (to be collected by the Camporee Medic and returned at end of camporee)

**UNITS ARE ADVISED TO EAT PRIOR TO THEIR ARRIVAL OR HAVE A PRE-PREPARED MEAL.**

## **CAMPSITES:**

Each Patrol/Webelos Den will receive their campsite assignment at registration. You will camp as a Patrol/Webelos Den. (Troops/ Packs with multiple Patrols/Webelos Dens will be assigned a Unit Site)

Patrols/Webelos Dens need to bring containers for the transporting and storage of water.

**NO! FIRES ARE PERMITTED IN CAMPSITE FIRE PITS. REPORT ANY FIRES TO CAMPOREE HEADQUARTERS!**

**NO OPEN FIRES!!!! Stoves or Charcoal are permitted if they are used in accordance with BSA Safety Guidelines.**

Dishwashing and the cleaning of pots and pans shall be done in your campsite!! The use of faucets or bathrooms is strictly prohibited!!!!

Scouts should follow the principles of “Leave No Trace.” Bring your own garbage bags. Bag and take home all of your own garbage.

#### **FIRST AID:**

First Aid is available at the Medical Tent.

Your Medical Forms will be with the Medical Staff in case of a major emergency!

Everyone should carry water, wear a hat and sunscreen.

#### **WARNING!!**

There are ticks, snakes and poison oak in the area! Stay in designated areas and check for ticks frequently!!

#### **UNIFORM:**

Class A uniform is required for Friday Night registration and Campfire, Saturday Assembly and Campfire, Sunday Assembly, Scouts Interfaith Service and Camporee Closing Ceremony.

Class B is appropriate for the rest of the Camporee.

Items of clothing with “message” other than Scouting are not permitted!!

## CONDUCT:

Everyone is expected to conduct themselves in a Scout like manner, living the Scout Oath and Law.

Follow the Outdoor Code and principles of Leave No Trace.

Stay within the camp boundaries.

Keep bathrooms clean.

Put trash in bags and take it home with you.

Respect others and be quiet after TAPS.

Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.

## VISITORS:

The Camporee is open to visitors, family and friends on Saturday. Visitors need to bring their own food or have made prior arrangements with their Unit/Patrol or Webelos Den.

## CAMPFIRES:

There will be two (2) Camporee campfires.

Friday Night will be presented by Camporee Staff.

Saturday Night will be presented by Camporee Patrols/  
Webelos Dens providing one song and one skit.

(These will be pre-approved)

Adults are encouraged to bring chairs and everyone a  
flashlight.

## COOKING COMPETITION:

There will be a Patrol/Webelos Dens Dessert  
Competition.

Prepare a cooked/baked dessert of your choosing.

At 7:15PM on Saturday Night, bring your entry to
