They purchased a house where young women feel safe, are supported, learn life skills, and receive mentoring. They learn to prepare for educational attainment, work readiness, and independent living.

Raoul from Camelot spoke to us about working with 18-23-year old youth who have aged out of foster care. They receive a stipend for their expenses. Services and support with My Sister's Place have been provided. Their goal is to help them become self-sufficient.

The Mad Hatter Tea Party will be September 22, 2019. The Kiwanis Club oversees this event, and the Angels will volunteer to help them.
