Byron Pressley of Friends of the Children reported he has fifty-three children on the roster. He thanked the Angels for their assistance. He is currently looking for a male mentor for the children.

Lisa Perry of Better Together said they partner with churches. They place children from families in crisis in homes temporarily.

Dena Hernandez of Pace Center helps girls from 11 – 17 years of age now in education. They are working on a career and college fair.

Linda Thielmann of Healthy Start works with families with substance abuse.

Damia Kelly of Boley Center reported they have broken ground on a new house in Whispering Pines. They also work with Destination Theater with a group who participates in plays and sets.

Kelly Johnson of the Sheriff's office introduced Samantha Taylor who talked about the transition to DCF. They are working on linking families with services specific to their needs.

FSS prepared a flyer talking about a new statute that allows for parental right reinstatement for those whose rights were terminated. After going through the reinstatement, a mother and daughter were reunited. There will be an Exhibition of Arts and Talent on June 22nd from 6 to 8 pm.
