Rick McClintock of Friends of the Children is looking for help. They will have a Tampa Bay Museum Event Gala in December and are looking for holiday dresses.

Head Start Jordan Park site is working toward family goals and looking for agencies to work with the kids.

Boley Center serves adults with major mental illnesses, also serves veterans. Looking for housing.

Pace will celebrate a soiree next week. They have a giving tree with wish lists. They have a point store where girls can redeem their points for items. They can earn points for making changes in their lives.
