
“I Used Those Prayers For A Few Months And God Answered!”

Helpful Household Hints

WINDOW WASHING

Everyone hates to wash windows. Make it easier to identify streaks by wiping in one direction on the inside of the pane, and in the other direction on the outside. That way you can see just where you need to wipe again!

STEAMING VEGGIES

Steamed veggies are so much healthier, but what if you don't have a steamer? Just put a metal colander over a pan of hot water, add your veggies, cover and steam until tender!

GOOD TO THE LAST BITE

To make yogurt, sour cream or cottage cheese last longer, store them in the fridge upside down! It sounds odd, but what happens is that doing so creates a vacuum at the top of the container and it

helps to reduce the bacterial growth. Just make sure you have a tight-fitting lid to avoid leaking.

WATERING PLANTS

Often when you water houseplants, some of the potting soil leaks out through the drainage hole in the bottom of the pot along with the excess water. Try putting a single paper coffee filter over the hole in the bottom of pots. That way, the excess water still drips out but the dirt stays in the pot!

LEMON TWISTS

Just 20-30 seconds in the microwave will give you double the amount of juice when you squeeze lemons. If you love fried fish, but hate the cooking odor, soak your fish in lemon juice and water for about 20 minutes before cooking ... gives a yummy flavor, too!

RECYCLE IT

Use an old dryer sheet to polish faucets in the kitchen and bathroom!

UN-STICK GLASSES

When two glasses or glass bowls are stuck together, put the bottom glass in warm water and pour cold water into the top one. They will separate and pull apart without breaking!

TEXAS ENCHILADAS

Member Betty D. says folks in her home state of Texas love a "Texas Twist" in their food. We think you'll like this zippy dish as well.

Ingredients: 4 tortillas . . . one 16 ounce can black beans, drained . . . 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese . . . 1 cup salsa . . . 1/2 cup sour cream.

Spread equal amounts of beans on each tortilla. Sprinkle equal amounts of cheese on top. Roll, starting from one side to form enchiladas. Place in baking dish and bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. Take from oven and top with equal amounts of salsa and sour cream.

BROCCOLI DELUXE

We are so glad that Member Annie G. from North Carolina sent this recipe to us. It is a real winner.

Ingredients: 1 package

chopped broccoli, cooked and drained . . . 1/2 cup mayonnaise . . . 1 can cream of mushroom soup . . . 1/2 cup grated cheese . . . 1 onion, chopped . . . 1 egg . . . 1 cup crushed stuffing mix . . . 1/4 cup butter, melted.

Blend mayonnaise, soup, cheese, onion and egg in a casserole. Add broccoli, top with stuffing mix, and drizzle with melted butter. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.

DESSERT PIZZA

It's yummy, quick and so easy! You can thank Member Princella P. from California for this unusual dessert idea. Her family never gets tired of it and always asks for her to make it.

Ingredients: One 20 ounce package refrigerated cookie dough, any flavor . . . 3 cups whipped topping . . . 2 cups assorted fruit, such as bananas, sliced strawberries, kiwi, pineapple, peaches or any other seasonal fruit.

Press cookie dough evenly into a 12-inch pizza pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes, until golden brown. Cool completely. Then, place cookie crust on a serving plate, spread with whipped topping and garnish with fruit. This makes 12 mouth-watering servings.


