12:00 Noon Prayer for Prosperity

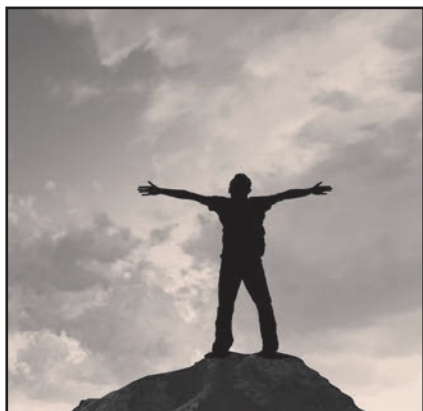

The Psalm above echoes the theme of this Faith Magazine, Dear Member, our declaration of praise for our Lord God.

I know that when I pray, there's a whole family all over the World praying with me. That makes me feel as if I am never alone. I know there is always someone praying with me and for me.

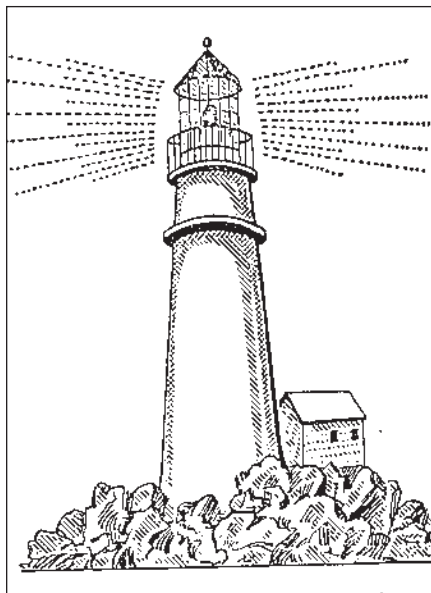
I have tried Fellowship's Prosperity Harvest Plan as well, and I know it works. I just need to discipline myself and start using it again. I need it so much!

GREASE RELIEF

The cooler weather means we're cooking more now, so you'll love this tip for minimizing grease. When washing greasy dishes, pots and pans, put a few drops of vinegar in the dish water to cut the grease!

DOREEN'S CHICKEN

Member Doreen from New Jersey says there's never a speck left over after a meal with her chicken dish. In fact, guests like it so much they've named this casserole after her.

Ingredients: 3 pounds chicken parts . . . 2 tablespoons oil . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ cup each of chopped red and green peppers . . . 1 small chopped onion . . . 3 small garlic cloves, crushed . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon ground ginger . . . 1 teaspoon oregano . . . 1 teaspoon dried parsley . . . salt and pepper to taste . . . 1 can cream of chicken soup, undiluted.

Brown chicken in oil and remove from pan. Saute remaining ingredients, except the soup, until soft, about 5 minutes. Add soup, bring to a simmer and cook 3 or 4 minutes.

Pour a little of the sauce in the bottom of a large casserole dish. Arrange chicken on top and pour remaining sauce over chicken.

Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour.

BAKED SQUASH

This is good even cold, according to Member Ruth from New York. Because squash is abundant and cheap in the fall it's also an economical meal.

Ingredients: 1 large or 2 small squashes, either yellow or zucchini . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ cup grated Parmesan cheese . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon seasoned salt . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon oregano . . . $\frac{1}{4}$ cup bread crumbs . . . 1 tablespoon butter.

Cut squash in half the long way, then dice carefully through the middle the long and short way, but do not cut through the shell. Sprinkle with seasoned salt, oregano, bread crumbs and finally with Parmesan cheese. Dot with butter and bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour, or until squash is good and soft.

MUD PIE

No dessert could ever be easier, and none more delicious, than this winning dish sent in by Member E.D. from Florida. .

Ingredients: 1 prepared chocolate crumb pie crust . . . $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon coffee ice cream . . . 1 jar hot fudge topping.

Fill pie crust with softened ice cream, smoothing top well. Spread topping over ice cream and freeze until serving time.

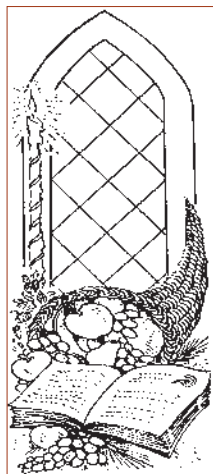

Stay On The Path Of Prayer To Connect With The Lord!

When you see a pathway, you know right away that you need to stay on that road, Dear Member. You know the path will keep you from wandering through a trackless forest because a pathway always leads somewhere.

Well, in Fellowship we sometimes talk about the “pathway of prayer” that leads you on a beautiful journey as you talk with the Lord. It is a spiritual path that leads to peace of mind and clarity of purpose, when you ask God to guide you and He reveals the direction He wants you to take.

Now, this isn’t a new pathway, Dear Friend. It actually has been in the same place for ages. But sometimes people have trouble finding it. And you are never alone on this path because the Lord is with you, too. If you’re connected to Him through prayer you can never become lost. He is your guide and has left signs for you to follow; we’ll explain about those in a minute.

The biggest sign, or gateway entering the path, is faith. You must have faith to first step through that entrance and start walking along the Lord’s prayer path. That requires having faith and belief in God and His power to lead you through life.

To have faith in the Lord means you have placed your life in His hands and trust Him com-

pletely. He knows what is best for us, and how we fit into His plan. What we think we want to do today may not be something that fits with God’s plan for us, which is why it’s important to seek His direction through prayer.

We must have faith in God’s plan for us and accept it without hesitation. When you can do that you can truly say you are walking along the Lord’s pathway of prayer, reaping the blessings it provides.

You’d be surprised how many people of faith get tripped up on that simple step, because we often start to think we know better than anyone what we should be doing. However, once you trust God to make those decisions, life will be a more peaceful, meaningful experience!
