All Jurisdictions to Offer Residential Permit Amnesty Program in May to Promote Building Safety.

Building Departments throughout the Las Vegas Valley will be celebrating Building Safety Month by offering amnesty throughout the month of May for self-disclosed residential construction work done without permits.

The amnesty period is Monday, May 1, through Wednesday, May 31.

During the amnesty period, homeowners throughout the valley will be subject to paying normal fees for permits, inspections and plan reviews, but not penalties. Fees for residential-related construction range from \$150 to \$400, depending on the project. Applications are submitted at your local building department or on-line at:
