The Kentucky Rural Health Association and the UK Center of Excellence in Rural Health invites you to submit poster proposals for the Annual Conference scheduled for November 15 & 16, 2018 at the WKU Knicely Center in Bowling Green, KY.

The goals of the KRHA conference are:

- Provide an overview of the state of rural health in Kentucky and inform participants of current efforts to improve rural health services.
- Provide a forum for participants to interact in order to gain a better understanding of the impact of various programs/organizations on rural health.
- Educate participants on how to become more skilled advocates for rural health, at the local, regional and state levels.

GENERAL SUBMISSION INFORMATION

- Submissions must follow the directions for the proposed category and must be complete. Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed.
- Presenters may not use any conference presentation to market products or services; exhibit space is available for that purpose.

*Space for up to 20 posters will be reserved to display research results, studies of educational evaluation, and descriptions of best practices or topics of general interest and **must include connect to a current or emerging rural health policy issue**. Authors will be responsible for mounting posters, being available to discuss their exhibit and removing posters.*

Abstracts describing your poster presentation must be limited to **250** words. KRHA and the UK CERH want abstracts on current and emerging rural health policy issues.

Submit proposals by **August 17, 2018** - If your poster is accepted, you will be notified by **September 21, 2018**.
