Parade Route

START: The City of Revelstoke Courthouse (Kootenay Street and Second Street)

1. Kootenay Street to First Street (turn right onto First Street)
2. First Street to Mackenzie Avenue (turn right onto Mackenzie)
3. Mackenzie Avenue to Ninth Street (turn left on Ninth)

END: At Queen Elizabeth Park

PLEASE NOTE: The parade will officially "end" at Ninth Street & Vernon to allow parade participants a chance to join us in Queen Elizabeth Park for the flag raising ceremony at 1pm.

PARADE INSTRUCTIONS

Date: MONDAY, JULY 1ST, 2019 – **Celebrating Revelstoke's 120th Birthday!**

Assembly Place: Court House and adjacent streets 11:30 am for judging & marshalling

Parade Starting Time: 12:00 noon

1. FLOATS

While generally the parade committee places no restriction on float dimensions if they are reasonable, Revelstoke By-Law permits vehicle width of 8 feet, height of 13 ½ feet, and length of 35 feet for a single vehicle and 40 feet for articulated vehicle. While these maximum dimensions are not applicable for the actual parade route, they are applicable whilst travelling to and from the parade route. However, you may obtain a permit to exceed the dimensions at Motor Carrier Branch. Notwithstanding this, the height of your vehicle must not exceed 13 ½ feet.

All floats should be of proper construction to alleviate chance of a break down during the parade. Decorative materials should be fire resistant.

2. RESTRICTIONS

- a) ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING CANDY AND/OR MERCHANDISE off devices of any kind from parade entries. Water is not to be thrown from the floats.
- b) No person is permitted to participate in the parade other than those selected or designated by the sponsor to appear therein. Any marchers must be in keeping with, and part of an entry. Groups of fans walking as such cannot be permitted entry.
- c) Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any participant. Any participant suspected of being under the influence will be barred from the parade.

3. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- a) PLEASE USE SAFETY RAILINGS AND/OR FASTEN SEATS FOR RIDERS.
- b) No smoking on or near floats. Carrying a fire extinguisher is required, must be in good working order and you need to know how to use it. Be sure that the exhaust pipe is not in contact with flammable materials. Be sure that the driver has adequate vision and ventilation. The vehicle must be in good mechanical condition and properly serviced. Good brakes are required.

4. The participants agree to hold harmless and indemnify the City of Revelstoke and the Parade Committee from all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from participation in the parade.
