	Public Records/Emergency Physicians; Defining the term "emergency physician"; providing exemptions from public records requirements for the personal identifying and location information of current or former emergency physicians and the spouses and children of such emergency physicians;		

providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing a statement of public necessity, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2026

SB 0844  **Sickle Cell Disease Care Management and Treatment** **Jones**
 Continuing...
 Sickle Cell Disease Care Management and Treatment Continuing Education; Revising requirements for a continuing education course on prescribing controlled substances which health care practitioners are required to complete; requiring the applicable licensing boards for specified health care professions to require a 2-hour continuing education course on sickle cell disease care management as part of the first licensure or certification renewal; specifying requirements for the course; authorizing the applicable boards to approve additional equivalent courses to satisfy the requirement, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2026

SB 1404  **Memory Care** **Burton**
 Memory Care; Defining the term “memory care services”; requiring facilities claiming to provide memory care services to meet specified standards of operation in providing such services; repealing a provision relating to special care for persons with Alzheimer’s disease or other related disorders; providing the purpose of the Florida Alzheimer’s Center of Excellence; defining terms; creating the center within the Department of Elderly Affairs, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2026

SB 0914  **Dry Needling** **Calatayud**
 Dry Needling; Defining the terms “dry needling” and “myofascial trigger point”; requiring the Board of Occupational Therapy to establish minimum standards of practice for the performance of dry needling by occupational therapists, including specified standards; requiring the board, if it deems it necessary for patient safety, to adopt additional supervision and training requirements for occupational therapists to perform dry needling on specified areas, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2026

Protective Investigation...

Specific Medical Diagnoses in Child Protective Investigations : Provides exception to requirement that DCF immediately forward certain allegations to law enforcement agency; requires such allegations to be immediately forwarded to law enforcement agency upon completion of department's investigation; requires child protective investigator to inform subject of investigation of certain duty; conforms cross-reference; requires Child Protection Teams to consult with licensed physician or advanced practice registered nurse with pediatric experience when evaluating certain reports; authorizes parent or legal custodian of child who is subject of protective investigation or shelter order to request specified examinations of child within specified timeframe; requires that certain examinations be paid for by parent or legal custodian making request or as otherwise covered by insurance; requires physician or advanced practice registered nurse who performed certain medical examinations to submit written report to department & certain persons within specified timeframe; requires department to immediately convene case staffing with specified persons. Effective Date: July 1, 2026

HB 0021  Pub. Rec./Agency Employees **Kendall**

Pub. Rec./Agency Employees: Provides exemption from public records requirements for certain identifying & location information of current or former agency employees & spouses & children of such employees; provides for retroactive application; specifies that exemption does not limit certain existing exemptions; provides for future legislative review & repeal of exemption; provides statement of public necessity. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

HB 0243  Electric Bicycles **Benarroch**


Electric Bicycles: Provides requirements for operation of electric bicycles; provides penalties; creates Electric Bicycle Safety Task Force adjunct to DHSMV & provides requirements therefor; requires certain reports to Governor & Legislature by specified dates. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

HB 4059  Compensation for Health Care Services for Inmates in Polk Co... **Albert**


Compensation for Health Care Services for Inmates in Polk County: Limits compensation to health care provider that provides medical services for inmate housed in Polk County detention center under certain conditions; limits compensation to entity that provides emergency medical transportation services for inmate housed in Polk County detention center if entity does not have contract with county to provide such services. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

HB 0569  **Forensic Client Services** **Chaney**

Forensic Client Services: Revises definition of "forensic client" to include person committed to involuntary residential services in a secure facility of the Agency for Persons with Disabilities, republishing s. 916.303, F.S., relating to determination of incompetency. Effective Date: July 1, 2026


HB 1069  **Background Screenings** **Trabulsy**

Background Screenings: Specifies additional disqualifying offenses under background screening requirements for certain persons; requires AHCA, beginning on specified date or as soon as practicable thereafter, to review & determine eligibility for all criminal history checks submitted to Care Provider Background Screening Clearinghouse by specified agencies; requires clearinghouse to share eligibility determinations with specified agencies; requires specified agencies & qualified entities to process exemptions from disqualification pursuant to specified provision; making technical change; provides that, beginning on specified date, independent sanctioning authority is considered qualified entity for purpose of participating in clearinghouse; prohibits independent sanctioning authority from allowing certain persons to act as athletic coaches beginning on specified date; authorizes person who has not undergone certain background screening to act as athletic coach if he or she is under direct supervision of athletic coach who meets certain background screening requirements. Athletics in Public K-12 Schools; Requiring the Florida High School Athletic Association to adopt bylaws authorizing a coach to support the welfare of a student by using personal funds to provide certain effects to the student; requiring the coach to report such use of personal funds to the association; providing that such use of personal funds is presumed not to be an impermissible benefit, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2026

SB 1362  **Advanced Air Mobility** **Harrell**

Advanced Air Mobility; Citing this act as the "Advanced Air Mobility Competitiveness and Infrastructure Act"; providing an exemption from the sales and use tax for certain electric vertical takeoff and landing aircraft and related items and for electricity used for certain training operations; defining the term "vertiport"; providing immunity from liability for certain vertiport operators; providing applicability; authorizing the department to fund up to specified percentages of vertiport project costs; requiring the department to expeditiously approve certain vertiports, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2026

HB 0635 	Cybersecurity Standards and Liability	Giallombardo
<p>Cybersecurity Standards and Liability: Prohibits local governments from imposing certain cybersecurity standards or processes on vendors; defines "vendor"; prohibits local governments from adopting or enforcing certain cybersecurity standards or processes; provides that local government, covered entity, or third-party agent that complies with certain requirements is not liable in connection with cybersecurity incident; requires covered entities & third-party agents to implement revised frameworks, standards, laws, or regulations. Effective Date: upon becoming a law</p>

<p>Acupuncture: Revises licensure requirements; provides applicability; exempts certain persons from certain regulations governing practice of acupuncture. Effective Date: July 1, 2026</p>		
HB 0439 	Practice of Chiropractic Medicine	Cobb
<p>Practice of Chiropractic Medicine: Revises definition of term "practice of chiropractic medicine"; authorizes chiropractic physicians to possess, prescribe, & administer vitamins, nutrient preparations, homeopathic remedies, dietary supplements, & epinephrine by specified means; requires chiropractic physicians to be certified by Board of Chiropractic Medicine to administer by injection vitamins, nutrient preparations, homeopathic remedies, dietary supplements, & epinephrine; provides requirements for certification program; authorizes licensed pharmacists to fill, compound, or dispense certain nutritional prescriptions for licensed chiropractic physicians under certain circumstances. Effective Date: July 1, 2026</p>		
HB 0743 	Prohibited Sex- reassignment Prescriptions and Procedures	Melo
<p>Prohibited Sex-reassignment Prescriptions and Procedures: Prohibits health care practitioner from aiding or abetting another in specified violation; authorizes Attorney General to conduct investigation & bring civil action against health care practitioner; provides for damages, injunctive relief, & civil penalties; provides that any damages collected shall accrue to injured minor. Effective Date: July 1, 2026</p>		
HB 1021 	Administration of Medications by Pharmacists	Young
<p>Administration of Medications by Pharmacists: Authorizes pharmacists, at direction of certain licensed physicians, to administer medications under certain circumstances. Effective Date: July 1, 2026</p>		


HB 1235 	Respiratory Care Interstate Compact	Conerly	<p>Respiratory Care Interstate Compact: Creates Respiratory Care Interstate Compact; provides purpose & objectives; requires member states to meet certain requirements to join & participate in compact; provides criteria that licensee must satisfy to practice under compact; provides requirements for renewal of equivalent license in member state; authorizes active military member & his or her spouse to be deemed as having home state license; requires member states to report adverse actions taken against license of occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant by other member states; establishes Respiratory Care Interstate Compact Commission; provides for jurisdiction & venue for court proceedings; provides membership, duties, & powers; requires member states to participate in exchange of specified information; authorizes commission to adopt rules & bylaws; provides for development, maintenance, & use of coordinated database & reporting system; requires member states to submit specified information to data system; provides requirements for information in data system; provides rulemaking procedures; provides for state enforcement of compact; provides for termination of compact membership; provides procedures for resolution of certain disputes. HB 1347 	Clinical Labratory Personnel	Gerwig	<p>Clinical Labratory Personnel: Requires that applicant who qualifies for licensure under specified provisions provide proof of such qualification & pay required fees to be eligible for licensure; requires that applicants for licensure as technologist or technician who meet specified criteria be deemed to have satisfied minimum qualifications for licensure to perform high or moderate complexity testing as technologist or technician, as applicable. Law Enforcement Officer Interactions with Individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder; Requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to establish a program to improve communication between individuals with autism spectrum disorder and law enforcement officers under certain circumstances; requiring the department to develop and make available to individuals with autism spectrum disorder a certain envelope by a specified date; defining the terms "agency" and "autism spectrum disorder"; requiring the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission within the Department of Law Enforcement to establish an employment training component relating to individuals with autism spectrum disorder, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2026

HB 0237  Use of Professional Nursing Titles **Salzman**

Use of Professional Nursing Titles: Authorizes persons who hold specified degrees to use certain titles & abbreviations; requires certain doctoral degree holders to specify their profession when using specified title. Effective Date: July 1, 2026


HB 0363  Dental Therapy **Chaney**

Dental Therapy : Authorizes Medicaid to reimburse for dental services provided by certain mobile dental units; creates Council on Dental Therapy; specifies licensure requirements, services, limitations, & prohibitions relating

to practice of dental therapy; requires DOH, in consultation with Board of Dentistry & AHCA, to submit reports to Legislature. Effective Date: July 1, 2026

HB 0375  Autonomous Practice by a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthet... Giallombardo

Autonomous Practice by a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist: Revises staff membership & clinical privileges for certain certified registered nurse anesthetists; authorizes certain certified registered nurse anesthetists to perform specified acts; revises practice requirements for autonomous advanced practice registered nurses; authorizes autonomous advanced practice registered nurses to perform certain acts. Effective Date: July 1, 2026

HB 0301  Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Autonomous Practice Shoaf




Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Autonomous Practice: Authorizes certain advanced practice registered nurses to engage in autonomous practice to provide mental health services. Effective Date: July 1, 2026
