








January 1, 2021, the FBI has retired the UCR Summary Reporting System (SRS) and transitioned to National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The FBI's transition to a NIBRS only data collection will improve the nations crime data through rich details and greater specificity of offenses. Due to this change Paradise Valley Police will compare one-year data versus three-year data.

- NIBRS include Crimes against Persons, Property & Society crimes.
 - o NIBRS collects data from 52 offenses, plus 10 additional offenses for which only arrests are reported.
- In December, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported 31 crimes to the FBI.
 - There was 1 crime against person, 29 property crimes and 1 crime against society.





CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons, e.g., murder, rape, and assault, are those whose victims are always individuals.

Simple **Assaults** decreased 80%


In December, persons crimes consisted of 1 simple assault case.



CRIMES AGAINST SOCIETY

Crimes Against Society, e.g., gambling, prostitution, and drug violations; they are typically crimes in which property is not the object.

In December, society crimes consisted of 1 drug/narcotic violation.




CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.


Thefts decreased

In December, property crimes consisted of 7 burglaries, 7 thefts, 1 motor vehicle theft, 1 forgery, 4 fraudulent activities, 3 impersonation (ID theft) and 6 property damage cases.






COMMUNICATIONS

Priority 1
Calls
decreased

In December, there were 1,193 routine calls, 1,200 dispatched calls, and 7 emergency calls. Officer initiated activity was at 2,463. The average response time for priority one calls was 4:05.

In December, there were 89 alarms. Officers assisted Phoenix Fire 14 times in December.


Alarms decreased 30%

In December, there were 14 noninjury collisions, 1 injury collision and 1 fatal collision.


