Serbia / Bosnia and Herzegovina / Republic of Macedonia

Building on our second well-received Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics International Provider Course in Novi Sad, Serbia in 2018, a Kybele team will attend the 9th School of Obstetric Anesthesia conference in Novi Sad, Serbia in April 2019, and identify future program needs. Continuing the momentum of the 4th School of Obstetric Anesthesia held in Tuzla, Kybele is also preparing for participation in the next joint meeting of the Society of Anesthesiologist of Republic of Srpska and Society of Anesthesiologists and Reanimatologists of Bosnia Federation. Additionally, Kybele members are preparing for joint research work with colleagues in Skopje, Macedonia and evaluating new possible sites.

Bolivia

New site for Kybele in 2019. Bolivia is the second poorest country and second highest infant and maternal mortality rates in the Western Hemisphere, with a neonatal mortality rate of 19.9 per 1000 live births (global target is 12), and maternal mortality rate of 206 per 100,000 live births (global target is 70).

Ukraine

New site for Kybele is 2019. Despite a reduction by half in the ratio of maternal mortality in the last decade, women are still dying at an unacceptably high rate of 120 deaths per 100,000 live births for a developed country. A site visit in 2018 revealed the need and demand for modern obstetric anesthesia care, which will begin with the hospitals in Ternopil, a city in Western Ukraine.

Ghana

Kybele successfully completed the 5-yr Making Every Baby Count initiative with PATH and a 2-yr project with USAID Systems for Health to improve referral systems for high-risk pregnancies. We eagerly anticipates the scale-up of our triage improvement package to six new health facilities under the Saving Lives at Birth initiative from 2019-20.




Every day, 830 women die from causes related to pregnancy and childbirth.

Worldwide, over 303,000 women die of maternal causes and 2.6 million babies die in the neonatal period each year. Almost all of these deaths are preventable and occur in low-resource settings, like the countries where Kybele operates.
