

RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP

All dogs in the Town of Wainwright must be licensed

According to Bylaw 2018-16:

- All dogs must have adequate food and water.
- All dogs must have protection from injurious heat.
- All dogs must be on a leash when on public property.
- The owner is guilty of an offense if the dog is running at large.
- The owner is guilty of an offense if the dog is barking or howling in an annoying or disturbing manner.
- The owner is guilty of an offense if the dog defecates on any public or private property and the owner neglects to clean up after it .
- The owner is guilty of an offense if he or she has more than 3 dogs.
- The owner is guilty of an offense if he or she fails to maintain a containment or structure that prevents the dog leaving the owner's property.
- The owner is guilty of an offense if the dog is confined to an unattended space (eg, vehicle) without adequate ventilation.
- All dogs **MUST BE LICENSED** within the Town unless the owner is visiting from another municipality.



According to Bylaw 2023-10:

- Fines and charges will be levied if the owner is deemed guilty of an aforementioned offense.
- Fines range from \$100 - \$800.
