Hard Plastic Containers, Tubs and Bottles. No Lids or Caps. (e.g. Detergent, Condiment or Shampoo Bottles Margarine and Large Yogurt Containers. Ice Cream Pails)



Aluminum and Tin Cans and Containers



Deposit Items Including: Mix Containers, Pop & Beer, Cans and Bottles. Tetra Paks



(e.g. Magazines, Flyers, Newspaper, Catalogues, Office Paper, Envelopes, Craft Paper, Shredded Paper, Books with front and back cover removed)



Cardboard - Flattened
