THE GOOD NEWS

Priest: The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke (24:13-35)

All: **Glory to you, Lord Christ.**

That same day, two of Jesus' followers were walking to a village called Emmaus, talking about everything that had happened. As they were walking, Jesus himself came near and began walking with them—but they didn't recognize him.

He asked them, "What are you talking about?"

They stopped, looking sad, and said, "Are you the only one who doesn't know what's happened in Jerusalem?"

They told him about Jesus—how he was a powerful teacher and prophet, how he was crucified, and how they had hoped he would rescue Israel. Then they said, "Some women from our group went to the tomb this morning. They didn't find his body, and they said he is alive!" Then Jesus said to them, "You're missing it. This was all part of God's plan." And he began to explain how the Scriptures pointed to all of this.

When they reached the village, they invited him to stay with them.

So he went in, and when they sat down to eat, he took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them. And suddenly, their eyes were opened—and they recognized him.

And then he disappeared.

They said to each other, "Didn't our hearts burn within us while he was talking with us on the road?"

Right away, they got up and went back to Jerusalem to tell the others, "It's true—the Lord is alive!"

THE OFFERING

WE SHARE A MEAL TOGETHER

(sit or kneel)

Beloved, Jesus often met people at tables— not to judge them, but to welcome them. To break bread. To remind them they belonged. To show them the Father’s love.

So come to this table— not because you’ve earned it, not because you’ve got it all together, but because you’re hungry... hungry for grace, for peace, for the embrace of a Father who has been waiting for you all along.

This is the table where shame has no seat, where striving ends, and love is poured out like wine. Come. Let yourself be fed. Let yourself be known. Let yourself be fathered by God. The table is ready. And so is the Father’s love.

The Priest says:

Loving God, we remember that on the night before he died, Jesus sat at a table with his friends. He took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is my Body, given for you. Do this to remember me.”

Then he took the cup of wine, gave thanks, and shared it, saying, “This is my Blood, poured out for you and for all, for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, remember me.”

Send your Holy Spirit upon this bread and this cup, that they may be for us the Body and Blood of Christ. And as we receive them, may we be filled with your love, renewed by your grace, and made one with Christ and one another. All this we ask in the name of Jesus, our Savior and our Friend. Amen.
