State Road (SR) 80/Southern Boulevard Eastbound to Northbound Off-Ramp at Australian Avenue Improvement Project

Eastbound SR 80/Southern Boulevard Exit Ramp to Australian Avenue To Close Overnight

The eastbound Southern Boulevard exit ramp to northbound Australian Avenue will be closed from 9 p.m. Thursday, September 22, to 5 a.m. Friday, September 23, to install a temporary barrier wall. Please follow the detour provided below.

Construction Cost: \$1.5 million

Construction Start: July 2022

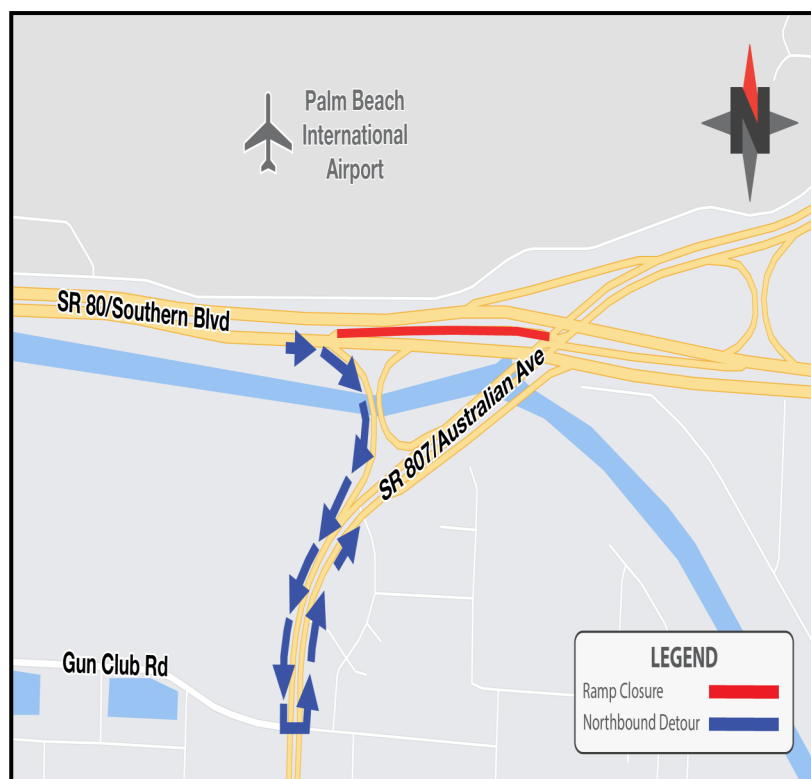
Estimated Completion: Early 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen eastbound SR 80/Southern Boulevard to include an additional 12-foot travel lane to northbound Australian Avenue (two-lane exit)
- Upgrade existing lighting along ramp with LED luminaries and add new signage
- Extend the existing retaining wall 500 feet to the west to accommodate the widening
- Mill and resurface the exit lanes to Australian Avenue

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- SR 80/Southern Boulevard will have up to two lanes closed during construction.
- Australian Avenue northbound ramp lane closures may occur from 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 a.m.
- Work zone speed limits have been reduced to 45 mph on SR 80/Southern Boulevard and reduced to 30 mph on the northbound Australian Avenue ramp.
