### SR A1A/BLEU HERON BOULEVARD BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Located in Riviera Beach, this project consists of replacing portions of the bridge deck in the outside westbound lane and repairing concrete on the bridge foundations. Improvements also include milling and resurfacing the roadway at each end of the bridge and adding new pavement markings.

Construction Cost: \$4.4 million

Construction Start: March 2023

Anticipated Completion: Late 2023

#### PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Please see below anticipated work, weather permitting, through April 10:

- Removing the traffic separator between the eastbound and westbound lanes
- Removing the bridge deck in the outside westbound lane

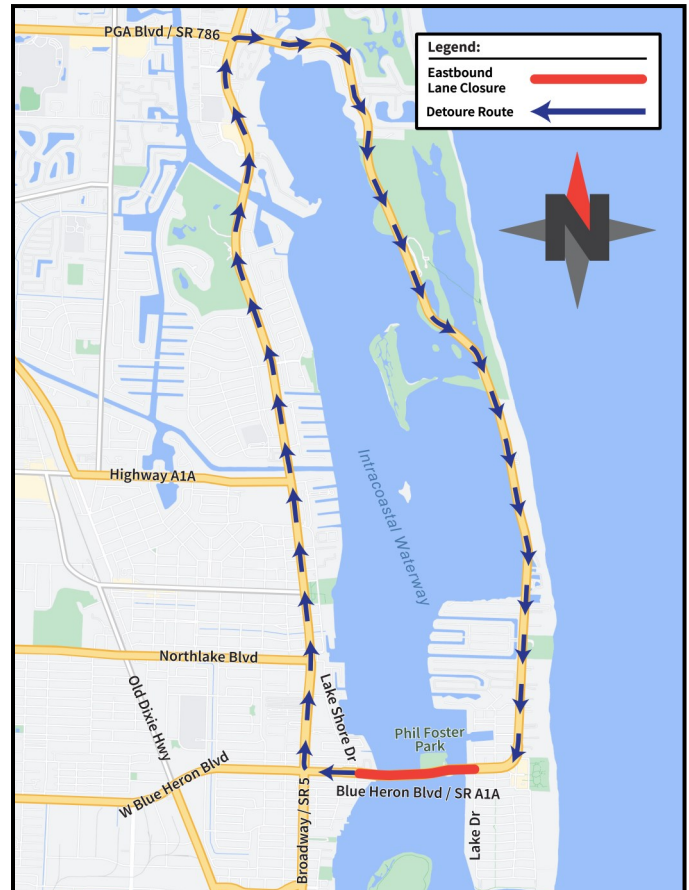
#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- One inside lane in each direction on Blue Heron Boulevard between Lake Shore Drive and Lake Drive will be closed continuously through Sunday, April 2. One inside westbound lane will be closed through Thursday, April 6.
- Blue Heron Boulevard's eastbound lanes, sidewalk and bike lanes between Lake Shore Drive and Lake Drive may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, April 4, through Thursday, April 6. Traffic will be detoured to SR 786/PGA Boulevard via US 1. Please see detour map.
- Blue Heron Boulevard's westbound lanes and sidewalk between Lake Shore Drive and Lake Drive will close beginning at 9 p.m. Thursday, April 6. Traffic will be diverted to the eastbound lanes with one lane of traffic and a bike lane in each direction. The westbound closure will be in place through August 2023.

#### PHIL FOSTER PARK

- The park, parking lot, fishing pier, docks, boat ramps and snorkeling trail are open.
- The FDOT right-of-way under the bridge is closed. The beach on the southeast side of the bridge is open.
