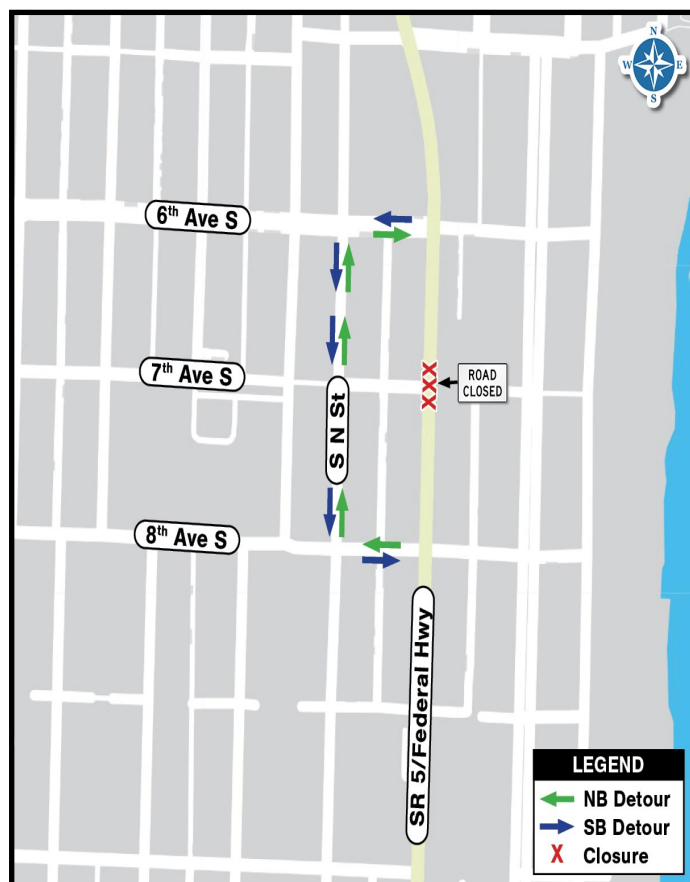
Construction Cost: \$2.3 million

DRAINAGE INSTALLATION AT THE INTERSECTION OF SR 5/FEDERAL HIGHWAY AND 7TH AVENUE S

- SR 5/Federal Highway at 7th Avenue South will be closed daily, 8 a.m. until 6 p.m., Monday, July 8 through Friday, July 12, for drainage pipe installation
- Motorists traveling northbound and southbound on SR 5/Federal Highway will be detoured via 6th Avenue South, South N Street, and 8th Avenue South.



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Adding drainage and constructing a raised intersection at 7th Avenue South
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Installing signalized pedestrian crossings with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB's) at 8th Avenue South, 3rd Avenue North, and 4th Avenue North
- Removing the existing midblock crossing between 4th Avenue North and 5th Avenue North
- Upgrading vehicular and pedestrian signalization at 6th Avenue South and 2nd Avenue North
- Installing lighting at the intersections of 8th Avenue South, 6th Avenue South, 2nd Avenue North, 3rd Avenue North, and 4th Avenue North
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings for shared bicycle facilities and buffered bicycle lanes
