Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.**

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) **MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES**

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CAMPBELL DRIVE TO TALLAHASSEE ROAD

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between Campbell Drive and Tallahassee Road (Milepost 3 to Milepost 7)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, September 29, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between Campbell Drive and Tallahassee Road (Milepost 3 to Milepost 7)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday, September 29, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened from four to six lanes from Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street to Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges within the corridor, interchange improvements at Biscayne Drive and Tallahassee Road and constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from Tallahassee Road. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2028. Approximate cost: \$99 million.

**TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 (Milepost 34 to Milepost 39)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

** Please note, access to businesses will be maintained.*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be installed as part of this project. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

**SOUTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 0X to 86)
and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869
MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES**

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 47 to Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2. A second lane may close at 9 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Detour information:

- Atlantic Boulevard traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel west on Sample Road to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Atlantic Boulevard traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road to Commercial Boulevard/SR 870, and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8) will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 5), travel east on Commercial Boulevard to Nob Hill Road, and travel north on Nob Hill Road/Coral Ridge Drive to access Atlantic Boulevard.
- Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8) will be directed to exit at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11), travel east on Sample Road to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to access Atlantic Boulevard.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, September 29, and daily through Friday, October 3.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

**SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 WIDENING
PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/SR 834**

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/SR 834 (Milepost 9 to Milepost 12)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Detour information:

- Sample Road/SR 834 traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to Sawgrass Expressway to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8), and travel east on Atlantic Boulevard to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.

Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Detour information:

- Sample Road/SR 834 traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to Atlantic Boulevard, and travel west on Atlantic Boulevard to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Coral Ridge Drive (Exit 14), and travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.

Eastbound Sample Road/SR 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, September 29, and daily through Friday, October 3.

Westbound Sample Road/SR 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, September 29, and daily through Friday, October 3.

** Please note, northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11) will not be closed at the same time.*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/SR 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT OVER L-38 CANAL AT MILEPOST 80

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 80

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

** Please note, northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will not be closed at the same time.*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 bridge approaches are being improved over the L-38 canal at milepost 80, in Palm Beach County. This project includes improving roadway safety by replacing the asphalt at the bridge approaches and installing new pavement markings. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$2 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188) **PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES**

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Milepost 86 to Milepost 87)

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2. A second lane may close at 10 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (Exit 81), travel west on Atlantic Avenue to US 441/SR 7, and travel north on US 441 to access Boynton Beach Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to improve traffic flow and safety. This project includes: a new westbound turn lane from Boynton Beach Boulevard to northbound Florida's Turnpike and an additional lane from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$9.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD/SR 802

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Milepost 87 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, September 28, to 5 a.m. Monday, September 29.
Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, September 29, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from West Palm Beach Service Plaza (Milepost 94)

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Thursday, October 2, to 6 a.m. Friday, October 3.

Detour information:

- West Palm Beach Service Plaza traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, travel south to exit at Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93), and travel east on Lake Worth Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD/US 98/SR 80

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between West Palm Beach Service Plaza and north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 98)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97)

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Thursday, October 2, to 6 a.m. Friday, October 3.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97), will be directed to exit at Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Exit 93), travel west on Lake Worth Road to SR 7, and travel north on SR 7 to access Southern Boulevard.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Southern Boulevard/SR 80

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Tuesday, September 30, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, October 1; and 10 p.m. Wednesday, October 1, to 6 a.m. Thursday, October 2.

Detour information:

- Southern Boulevard/SR 80 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel west to SR 7/US 441, travel south on SR 7 to Lake Worth Road/SR 802, and travel east on Lake Worth Road to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Southern Boulevard/SR 80 (Exit 97)

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 29, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 30.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Southern Boulevard/SR 80 will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Boulevard (Exit 99), travel west on Okeechobee Boulevard to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access Southern Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/SR 882, Southern Boulevard, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, September 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and the roadside improved from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.
