SR 802/Lake Worth Road Improvements Project from Raulerson Drive to Palm Beach State College Entrance

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting and an In-person Construction Open House on Wednesday, August 17, 2022 for the SR 802/Lake Worth Road Improvements Project from Raulerson Drive to the Palm Beach State College Entrance/Douglas Drive. The Virtual Public Meeting will take place from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., with the In-person Construction Open House to follow from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$14 million

Construction Start: August 2022

Estimated Completion: Summer 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Constructing a new exclusive right turn lane from eastbound Lake Worth Road into the Mid-County Senior Center
- Installing new seven-foot bike lanes with upgraded safety features
- Milling and resurfacing Lake Worth Road in both directions
- Replacing underground Palm Beach County utilities throughout the project limits
- Improving sidewalk and driveways on both sides of Lake Worth Road
- Modifying medians to improve motorist safety
- Improving signalized intersections and pedestrian crossings
- Installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the traveling public
- Lane closures will not occur from 3:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., Monday through Sunday. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times.
- Active work areas will be limited to the below segments to minimize public impact:
 - Raulerson Drive to Kirk Road
 - Kirk Road to Davis Road
 - Davis Road to S Congress Avenue
 - S Congress Avenue to Palm Beach State College Entrance
- Driveway and street access will be maintained at all times.
