



SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT APPLICATION IS NOW OPEN
CLOSES JANUARY 31, 2025

BEFORE YOU APPLY, YOU MUST WATCH THIS APPLICATION WORKSHOP!



Applications are now open for the FDOT Safe Routes to School (SRTS) program, a statewide effort to help children walk and bike to school safely. SRTS grants help fund roadway improvement projects near schools. Applications close January 31, 2025.



ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS

Elementary, middle, and high schools built before 2021.



ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Applicants must be the school or local government agency that will be responsible for maintaining the project after completion. Applicants must also attend a live training or watch a recorded training about the application process.



CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

To get your certificate for attending a recorded training:

1. Visit the link in the description and select your FDOT District
2. View your District's training in full
3. Fill out the web form (see the link in the description)
4. Await confirmation from the Florida Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP) Center, which will take about two weeks.
