SR 80/SOUTHERN BOULEVARD RESURFACING AND BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Construction Open House both in person and virtually regarding upcoming improvements to SR 80/Southern Boulevard from east of Parker Avenue to west of Washington Road in the City of West Palm Beach. Participants may attend in person or online. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions.

Construction Cost: \$3.8 million

Construction Start: April 2023

Anticipated Completion: Fall 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurfacing the roadway
- Replacing damaged sidewalk
- Replacing bridge deck joints
- Repairing the concrete traffic railing
- Rehabilitating and painting the steel beams over Georgia Avenue
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, lighting and signage
- Adding new pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- SR 80/Southern Boulevard may be closed between Lake Avenue and US 1/South Dixie Highway from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday for bridge joint repairs. Traffic will be detoured to Nottingham Boulevard via Lake Avenue and US 1/South Dixie Highway.
- Georgia Avenue will be closed under the bridge during steel beam rehabilitation. Traffic will be detoured to Lake Avenue via Nottingham Boulevard and Roseland Drive.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk closures.
- Access to adjacent properties and businesses will be maintained.
