RESURFACING, RESTORATION, AND REHABILITATION (RRR) PROJECT
 State Road (SR) 710/Beeline Highway from west of
 Park of Commerce Boulevard to east of Aviation Boulevard
 Palm Beach County, Florida

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the above referenced project within Palm Beach County. This public meeting will be offered in-person and virtually simultaneously. The public meeting will have representatives available to answer questions. Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by contacting the Project Manager. PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Remove the existing asphalt pavement and replace it with concrete for a longer life and add roadway shoulders to increase safety.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstruct the existing roadway with concrete pavement to enhance durability and improve infrastructure resiliency.
- Widen the existing paved shoulders to meet minimum standards: 5-foot paved outside shoulders and 4-foot paved inside shoulders.
- Implement drainage improvements to accommodate the new concrete pavement.
- Replace and upgrade signs and pavement markings to meet current standards and increase reflectivity.
- Replace asphalt approach slabs to bridges with concrete pavement approaches.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community.
- SR 710/Beeline Highway eastbound and westbound traffic will be placed on one side of the roadway (one lane in each direction) to facilitate construction of the new pavement.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained during construction.

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Anticipated Construction Start: **Fall 2027**
- Anticipated Construction End: **Fall 2029**
- Estimated Construction Cost: **\$65 Million**


