DRAINAGE INSTALLATION AT THE INTERSECTION OF LAKE WORTH ROAD AND KIRK ROAD

- Beginning 8 p.m., Sunday, April 2, 2023, northbound and southbound Kirk Road at Lake Worth Road will be closed through 5 a.m. Monday, April 3, 2023 for installation of the force main. Monday night, April 3, 2023 will be used as a contingency date if needed.
- Motorists traveling northbound and southbound on Kirk Road will be able to access Lake Worth Road from the outside right turn lanes.
- Motorists traveling eastbound and westbound on Lake Worth Road will not be impacted.
- Detour routes will be marked along SR-802/Lake Worth Rd, Kirk Rd, S Military Trl, Melaleuca Ln, Davis Rd, and 10th Ave N, as noted on the detour map provided
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Constructing a new exclusive right turn lane from eastbound Lake Worth Road into the Mid-County Senior Center
- Installing new seven-foot bike lanes with upgraded safety features
- Milling and resurfacing Lake Worth Road in both directions
- Replacing underground Palm Beach County utilities throughout the project limits
- Improving sidewalk and driveways on both sides of Lake Worth Road
- Modifying medians to improve motorist safety
- Improving signalized intersections and pedestrian crossings
- Installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting
