Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What are the hours/weeks of operation? Camp David is open daily from 6:30 AM to 5:30 PM.

Weeks of Operation: May 27th - June 20th (4 Weeks)

Mid-Summer Break: June 23rd – June 27th (1 Week – Camp David will be closed)

Weeks of Operation: June 30th – July 25th (4 Weeks)

Independence Day: Friday, July 4th (Camp David will be closed)

2. What are the fees? There are THREE PAYMENT OPTIONS.

*One Payment: \$1,000 (\$200 Savings) | Due: Friday, 5/23

*Two Payments: \$540/each (\$120 Savings) | Due: Friday, 05/23 & Friday, 06/27

*Weekly Payments: \$150/Week

Due on the following Fridays: 5/23, 5/30, 6/6, 6/13, 6/27, 7/4, 7/11, 7/18

The Parents/Guardians must commit to FULL PAYMENT for their chosen option.

The Parent/Guardian is responsible for fees whether the child is "present" or "absent." Parents/Guardians who violate the payment policy may not return to the summer camp program or attend the academy until all fees have been paid in full.

- 3. **Do you offer sibling discounts?** There are no sibling discounts.
- 4. **Are meals provided?** Breakfast, lunch, and a snack will be provided, but students may also bring their own food.
- 5. What does the Registration Fee cover? The \$300 Registration Fee covers the cost of weekly field trips, on-site activities, an academic workbook, and a Camp David T-shirt.

 The Parent/Guardian must select a TUITION PAYMENT OPTION after the Registration Fee is paid.
- 6. **How is Camp David staffed?** Camp David is staffed with the same familiar faces as during the school year. Our faculty and staff members are 12-month employees.
- 7. When is the registration deadline? The registration deadline is Friday, 5/16/25.

- 8. What ages may enroll in Camp David? Camp David serves students ages 2 to 12 (entering 7th grade). All preschool students must be potty-trained (stay dry for 2 hours and wear underwear; no pull-ups or diapers). We only accept two AND three-year-old students who are ALREADY enrolled in Seeds of Faith Christian Academy for the upcoming school year.
- 9. What are the planned field trips? Beginning the second week of camp, the students have a field trip every Thursday. The trips will be a combination of on-site and off-site.
- 10. What are the academic focuses? Students have four days of academic enrichment focusing on Reading, Math, Science, and Language Arts. Academics are scheduled from 8:30 am -12:00 pm daily.
- 11. **Are the younger students required to take a nap?** All students five years and under must have at least 90 minutes of rest each day and bring two large towels (no blankets) for their assigned cots.
- 12. Are the students required to arrive each morning at a particular time? No, students may arrive at any time convenient for their parent/guardian. Students should arrive early on field trip days.
- 13. What is the daily attire? Students may dress casually each day. Open-toe shoes, such as sandals and flip-flops, are not allowed on the playground; students must bring a pair of sneakers onsite. Students are required to wear Camp David t-shirts on all field trips.
