In addition to the formula Block Grant, the Division oversees grants for Special Projects of Regional and National Significance (SPRANS) and supports technical assistance to states and jurisdictions. - Oversee a multi-disciplinary staff which is located at HRSA Headquarters as well as 10 HHS Regional Offices across the country.

- Serve as the Director for the Division of State and Community Health and as such exercises full authority in planning, managing and directing national programs for which DSCH is responsible.
- Serve as the national voice and expert on the MCH Block Grant including the authorizing statute, regulations, policy issues, national performance measures and other issues pertaining to the implementation of the program.
