

Veterans flew from **Greensboro, North Carolina to Washington, D.C. on April 8th**, where they spent the day touring memorials dedicated to each branch of the U.S. Armed Forces, as well as monuments honoring their service and sacrifice. It was a day filled with reverence, reflection, and deep appreciation.

We are especially proud to share that **our very own parishioner, Commander Tina Illig-Rudge, wife of Brother Hank Rudge** was among those honored. She served our country with distinction for **21 years in the United States Navy**, including overseas duty in the **15th Naval District, Panama Canal Zone, Naval Station Rodman**. She retired in 1995 with the rank of **Commander (CDR)**.



This Honor Flight carried true American heroes: **3 WWII Veterans, 12 Korean War Veterans, and a large group of Vietnam Veterans**—representing **every branch of our U.S. military**. Among the veterans and their dedicated guardians, there were **27 Purple Heart Recipients**. These numbers reflect more than history—they reflect courage, sacrifice, and the unshakable spirit of those who served.







Over 500,000 pounds of food has been distributed in our Diocese, including almost 265,000 pounds in the Winston-Salem/Greensboro areas. This effort helped over 10,000 Men, women and children, including 1,450 families in our area. As it becomes more difficult to acquire additional food, especially during this inflationary period, the Agency is working overtime to assure that every family needing food or other services is able to receive them.

Mental health, Senior, Refugee and other programs are checking on their patients, assisting them with access to information and resources, applying for appropriate benefits, and ensuring that children are completing school assignments and doing well emotionally.

Veteran Services case coordinators continue to ensure that Veterans are stable. Catholic Charities is also providing supportive services specifically to very low-income veterans their families at risk of homelessness, with the ultimate goal of ending homelessness among our veterans.


