

Help Parkinson's Disease research in a clinical trial enrolling participants now. Participate in a Parkinson's Disease research study today!

The ASCEND research study is evaluating an investigational treatment for those with Parkinson's Disease.

If you or someone you know has been diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease, you or they may be eligible to participate in a clinical research study evaluating the safety and efficacy of a new investigational treatment. The study is evaluating an oral tablet for those with early, untreated Parkinson's Disease. The tablet will be taken only once a day with the largest meal. Approximately 60 participants will be recruited for this study and those enrolled will be asked to participate for up to 18 weeks, which includes the screening, treatment, and post-treatment follow-up periods.

Study Criteria

To participate in this study, participants:

- Are age 30 and older
- Have a clinical diagnosis of Parkinson's Disease
- Are not currently receiving any medication for Parkinson's Disease
- Have not previously received any medication for Parkinson's Disease for more than 28 total days at a time
- Are freely ambulatory (with or without assistive device)

Other eligibility criteria apply. Study participants receive study drug at no cost, and compensation for time and travel may be available.*
