Important Financial Aid information

Seniors and Parents/Guardians:

Two very important applications opened on **October 1st**. Both applications can help your senior earn scholarships and/or grants to help pay for college. Below is a brief description of each:

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

The FAFSA application will help some students qualify for up to \$6000 in Pell Grant (money from the Federal Government that does not need to be paid back) or additional institutional aid.

You will need a copy of the parents/guardians 2019 taxes to complete this application. The Pell Grant is need based therefore based on income some families may or may not qualify. It is best for every family to complete the FAFSA as institutions may be able to provide additional institutional aid, need or merit based, if the FAFSA is on file.

Students will need to create an FSA ID username and password prior to starting the FAFSA application. The FSA ID serves as an electronic signature in order to submit the FAFSA application via the website. Each senior should create his/her own FSA ID username and password as one or both parents/guardians should as well.

Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA)

The FFAA must be completed in order for students to receive the Bright Futures scholarship as well as many other scholarships and grants offered by the state of Florida.

Students must complete this application as soon as possible and continue to work on meeting all eligibility requirements for Bright Futures prior to the end of their senior year.

Students may qualify for other scholarships if they do not meet the requirements for Bright Futures. For more information, visit the following link:
