Testing Information

- ❖ All state assessments can only be administered on campus.
- ❖ State assessment graduation requirements have NOT been waived by the Florida Department of Education due to COVID-19.
- ❖ All students will receive an email on their school email account from Ms. Cecilio, testing coordinator, informing them of the test they need to take to meet the graduation testing requirements.
- ❖ LaunchED@Home students must respond to the email, via the link included, in order to be scheduled for the test.
- ❖ After submitting the response, if the student is willing to test on campus, the student will receive an email with the testing date and room #. (FSA ELA is a 3 day test and FSA Algebra & Geometry is a 2-day test.)
- ❖ If the student is not comfortable testing onto campus, they may meet the graduation requirement through a concordant score achieved with the SAT, PSAT NMSQT and/or ACT. Please visit [FLDOE Testing requirements](#) for detailed information.
- ❖ Testing is being administered in small groups and beginning with seniors and timely responses, this may cause a delay in the notification to underclassmen. Please be patient, we will schedule all students.
- ❖ Students **MUST** wear a mask, bring picture ID, school-issued laptop, charger, and wired headphones for the reading portion on testing day.
- ❖ LaunchED@Home students are to report to the front office on the day of testing for registration purposes.
