

The Valencia Horizon Scholars – Take Stock in Children Program is looking for students who are enthusiastic about pursuing post-secondary education and will be selecting new students to join the program in the fall of their freshman year!



Students are selected based on:

- 1) Academic performance: unweighted GPA of at least 2.5
- 2) Family income level (please see chart below) and qualify for free and reduced lunch program
- 3) An interview where they demonstrate a desire to pursue a post-secondary education
